## Help Sheet - TPN Pricing within Loadmaster

You can charge customers in a variety of ways but to retain a TPN style of charging use the TPN Pricing Override. This is found on Setup/Networks/TPN/TPN Pricing/ TPN Global Pricing Override.

To replicate the charges from one zone to another pick an existing rate and put a value in this To Zone box To Zone Clone 🆘 then hit CLONE						
To replicate the charges from one service to another pick an existing rate and put a value in this Service Service Clone 5						

Choose the Service then fill the screen out as required.

You tick the Use box to apply the different types of freight. The boxes marked with a \* are added to the computed charges and in general should be zero.

Looking at this example -

1 quarter pallet will be charged at £35.00 and each one thereafter will be charged at £35.00.

To charge extra pallets at £34.00 you would place 34 on the 'Then charge' field.

To charge the first 2 pallets at £35.00 and the subsequent at £34.00 you place a 2 on the 'Upto items' field and then 34 on the 'Then charge field'.

The Override Quarter pallet field is used where you want to charge the 'Then charge' value on all the pallets when it goes beyond the 'Upto items' instead of just adding the new totals to the running totals. Note the CLONE buttons which allow copying to other regions and services.
